Six references shall be listed on the Eagle application. This form shall be provided to five of those references (four if no employer and parent only if there is no organized religious association). A separate form is provided for the Scoutmaster.

Scout _____ is a candidate for the rank of Eagle Scout, Scouting's highest award. Attaining such an award is a distinguished honor to the Scout's personally, his/her parents and his/her Scout leaders. It follows, naturally, that its presentation should be made only to those who are unquestionably deserving of it.

It is the responsibility of the Board of Review for Eagle Scouts to review the qualifications of candidates who apply for this rank. The Board of Review is made of business and professional persons of the community.

The Scouting America movement has one aim in common with the home, school, and church: that of building solid character of the youth of the nation. It is a relatively simple task to ascertain the capabilities of individuals on such tangible skills as camping, swimming, first aid, cooking, signaling, etc. The Eagle Board of Review, however, feels that to attain the rank of Eagle Scout, the candidate must go beyond mastering the mechanics of the prescribed skills. Character is built on such intangible factors as attitude, leadership, acceptance of responsibility, and others.

Such attributes are revealed only by long periods of association with an individual. Since these traits are more likely to be revealed in the home, church, school and community, the Eagle Board of Review requests your aid in determining this Scout's qualifications for the Eagle rank. On page two (2) of this form is a tabulation of various points on which the Board of Review for Eagle Scouts would like for you to grade the Scout. You may also submit a reference letter. Please return this form/letter in a self-addressed envelope provided to you by the Eagle Scout candidate. Your remarks will be held confidential and be seen only by the Eagle Review Board.
